Cliffside Overlook


...On the edge, Maine stretches out in every direction. The forest oversees into ocean. The view makes the climb worth it, reminding me how small I am against the views.

Not all of Maine is rugged cliffs. Just around the bend, the ocean softens into calm beaches and hidden coves. It's a place to breathe, reflect, and relax.






Thunder Hole
